# **Planning**

- Work out a schedule
- Aim to finish well before submission date
- No extensions allowed



## Preparation – One Approach

- 1. Read question and guidance carefully
- 2. Construct multiple cause diagram
- 3. Use "mind map" / "spray diagram"
- 4. Organise ideas into structure
- 5. Look in course materials for evidence
- 6. Prepare diagrams, figures and tables
- 7. Revisit and revise ideas and structure
- 8. Start writing



## Multiple Cause Diagram

- Compulsory part of ECA
- Worth 12 marks out of 100
- To support analysis of "positive and negative effects of technology on environmental sustainability"



## Multiple Cause Diagram

To show positive and negative effects, construct either

- one diagram
  - label arrows to differentiate positive and negative effects
- two diagrams
  - One for positive and one for negative effects
  - Ensure both diagrams suitably titled



#### Presentation

- Structure
  - Headings and sub-headings
  - Paragraphs
- Use tables and diagrams
  - Where appropriate!
- Spacing
- Margins



## **Tables and Diagrams**

- Use to present and summarise data
- Good tables and diagrams can
  - make it easy for reader to understand complex information
  - save on word count



# **Tables and Diagrams**

- Think carefully about
  - information you want to convey
  - type and design
  - location
- Titles and labelling
  - always give a title
  - clear labelling



## Referencing

- In text
  - Author's name and date
  - e.g. Smith 1998; Smith and Jones 2002
- In bibliography
  - Full details
  - Format depends on reference type



## Example

- In text
  - Morris D and Carr S (2002)
- In bibliography
  - Morris D and Carr S (2002) *T172*, Theme 3, Section 3



## Example

- In text
  - PRe Energy Consultants
- In bibliography
  - PRe Energy Consultants, Life cycle assessment (LCA) or Ecobalance: an introduction [online] Available from http://www.pre.nl/lca.html [Accessed 5 May 2004]
