### WHITE WINES

### Pinehurst (Moreson Estate)

Chenin Blanc 2004-12.5%. Hints of guava on the nose, easy drinking wine which can be enjoyed on its own or with salads. - W.O. Coastal- Franschoek. £6.25

Chardonnay 2004 Unwooded- approachable style of this occasionally difficult unoaked style. Light and fresh, tropical nose with buttery hints, leaving vanilla on the aftertaste. 13.5% £7.25

### Raka Stanford

Sauvignon Blanc 2004- Grassy, Green peppers and asparagus flavours, a fresh and lively wine with time on its side.12.5% alc. £7.95

### Rosé 2004

Made from 18% Sangiovese and 82% extracted juice. The Sangiovese spend one month in French oak. A delightful nose of strawberries and rose petals with a slight lemon palate and a long elegant finish. Dry (1.91g/1 sugar) £6.25

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### RED WINES

### Pinehurst (Moreson Estate)

Cab Sauv 2001- Michealangelo International Award Gold Medal winner, packed with sweet black fruits, eucalyptus spices and a rich, long finish. 14%, 14 months on oak. £9.50

#### Raka

Pinotage 2004- Full bodied dark colour, banana nose with a spicy welcome but a long lingering smooth aftertaste. 14.5%. ABSA Top 10 Pinotage 2005. £9.85

Spliced 2003-A blend of mainly Cabernet and Ruby Cabernet, with Shiraz and Merlot, and a splash of Petit Verdot. Herbaceous nose with a palate of ripe cherries, chocolate and smokiness-delicious!ALC: 14% £9.25

#### Stark

Coastal Shiraz 2002-Jose Conde's very excited by his first Shiraz release. Dominant plum and red-berry fruit flavours with the characteristic tar and spice giving support in the background. Quite bold, but not over-the-top. 8000 bottles made.ALC: 14.5% £15.75
