

Beating the Boundaries

In aid of St Peter's Church Funds

Bank Holiday Monday 4th May 2015

The walk begins at the Church, assemble at 10.30 am

Building on the success of the last year, this year's walk will once again be a round trip walk taking in the villages of Barford, Sherbourne, Hampton Lucy, Charlecote and Wasperton – the opposite way round this time! A chance to go across private land along the River Avon and experience Shakespeare's Avon Way!

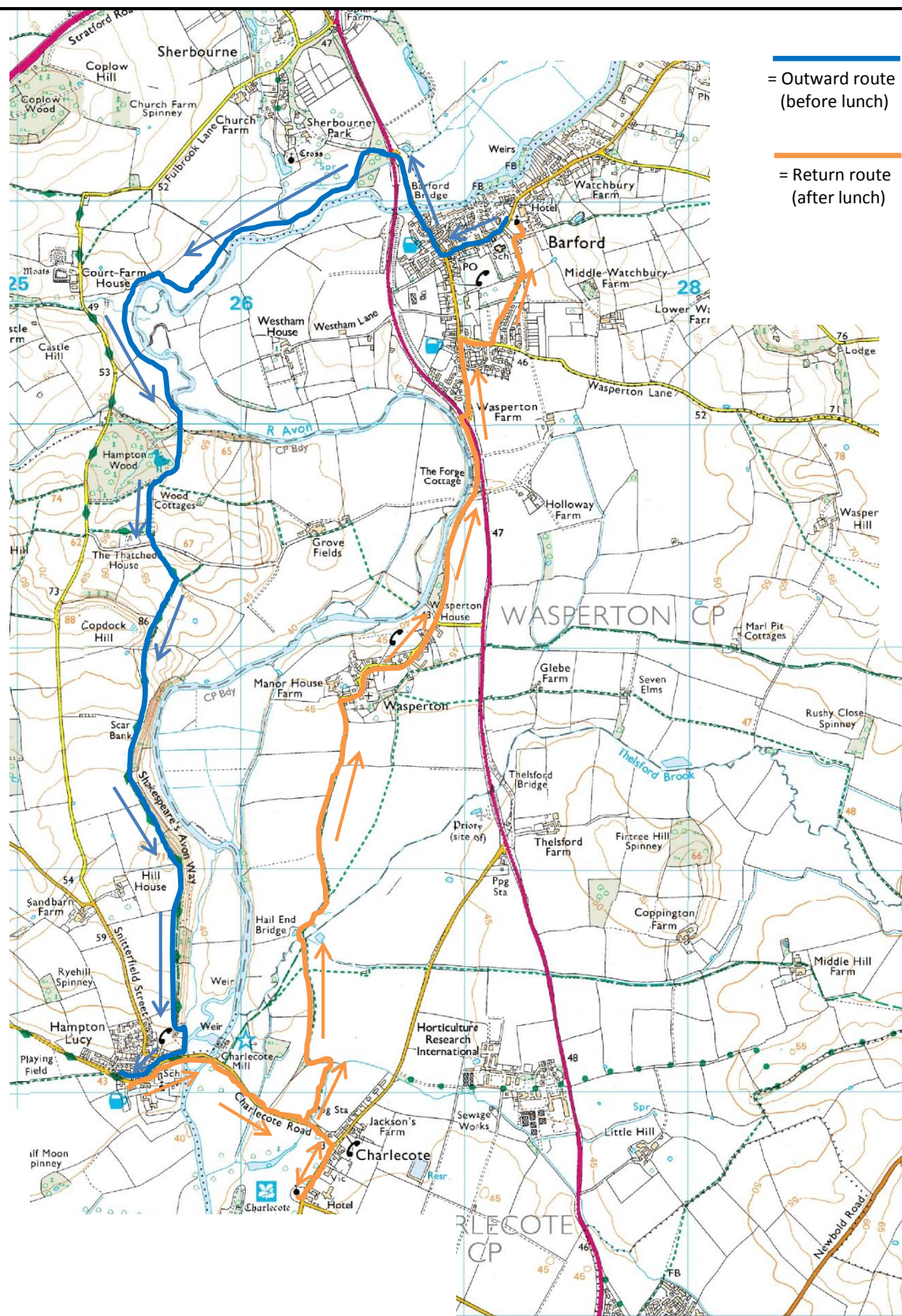


Route map can be found on the reverse:

- For the outward walk, head down Church Street and turn right to cross over the old bridge and then go left through the slipway gate just before the bypass junction.
- Follow the waymarkers under the bypass bridge and then alongside the river and through the fields to Hampton Wood. Note that all this section is across private land, with permission kindly granted by the landowners. Please follow the waymarkers at all times.
- After Hampton Wood, cross the driveway and follow Shakespeare's Avon Way round Copdock Hill and along the ridge to Hampton Lucy – emerging just by the bridge over the river.
- Turn right and then left to go past the school and pub to Hampton Lucy Village Hall where lunches will be available – ring the Rectory on 01926 624238 for further details.
- A visit can be made to Hampton Lucy church which will be open and also the Boar's Head pub.
- The return route goes over the bridge and along the road towards Charlecote (keep to the pavement at all times). Just after the speed limit signs, at a double gate on the left, take the more easterly footpath back to Wasperton – this will be clearly waymarked.
- There is an option to carry on along the road and turn right at the junction to walk into Charlecote and back if you want to see the village or the church which will be open. If you do this, return the way you came back to the footpath.
- Turn right along the lane through Wasperton and as you pass the last houses, take the footpath on the left by the big oak tree on the right hand bend. Follow this across the fields and through the woods until you come out on the A429.
- Turn left and walk along the pavement back to Barford, crossing the A429 at the southern bypass junction (*take extra care when crossing the main road here*). Turn up Wasperton Lane and then return to the church along the path through the allotments.
- Well behaved dogs are welcomed - on leads at all times please.
- The paths are not suitable for pushchairs.
- The routes will be fully waymarked, blue arrows for the outward route and orange arrows for the return route from Hampton Lucy - you are welcome to do parts of the walk only.

*This is a sponsored walk to raise money for St Peter's Church funds.
Please complete the separate entry form attached and hand this in at the registration point at the start of the walk outside the church.
Self-sponsorship is welcome: suggested minimum £7 for adults.*

Please also note the Gift Aid declaration on the entry form that we would ask you and/or your walk sponsors to complete if appropriate. By so doing the Church will be able to reclaim tax on your donation.

 Hampton Lucy to Barford via Wasperton – 1h 30m
