

# Your refuse and recycling collections will NOT change over Christmas

We will be working as normal on all bank holidays including Monday 27 December 2021, Tuesday 28 December 2021 and Monday 3 January 2022 to collect your refuse and recycling. However, to ensure we can collect the increased recycling and refuse, there will be no green bin collections during this period.



There will be NO green bin collections between Monday 27 December 2021 – Friday 7 January 2022

Food waste can be placed in your grey bin during this time



Green bin collections will resume from Monday 10 January 2022 and Christmas trees can then be collected on your next scheduled collection date. Simply cut the tree into pieces and put it in your green bin. Alternatively, you could arrange a collection to support charity, details below.

Please ensure your bins, boxes and bags are presented at the edge of your property by 7am on your collection day.

## Christmas tree recycling

This year we are supporting two great local charities, The Myton Hospices and Pass The Smile, who offer a real Christmas tree collection and recycling service from your doorstep for a small donation. Put this in a sturdy bag or small box (please keep each material separate) and place beside your red boxes and bags. Please flatten or cut large cardboard into pieces no larger than 1m x 1m.
