COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW - BARFORD/WASPERTON PARISH BOUNDARY

Under the provisions of the above Act the District Council is empowered to undertake community governance reviews with a view to considering the electoral arrangements in the whole or part of its district.

At the request of the Barford, Sherbourne and Wasperton Joint Parish Council the District has agreed to undertake a review with the following terms of reference:

To review the Barford/Wasperton parish boundary between points A and B on the attached plan with a suggested amendment to show a revised boundary between points A and C on the plan.

The proposed change of boundary is intended merely to transfer the properties which have been built since the boundary was last reviewed from the parish of Wasperton into the parish of Barford.

As part of the review the Council are required to consult the local government electors for the area under review and any other person or body which appears to the Council to have an interest in the review.
