185. Revised Standing Orders

It was noted that NALC had published a new model set of standing orders incorporating new requirements such as those to be observed under the new Code of Conduct.

As requested by the Council the Consultative Committee had examined the new orders and submitted their recommendations for the adoption of revised Standing Orders.

Members discussed the new proposals and decided that further revisions should be made to the Orders recommended by the Consultative Committee.

It was noted that no terms of reference for the Consultative Committee had been included in the Orders proposed for adoption.

- b) to investigate if terms of reference were specified for the Consultative Committee when the Committee was first established and to report back on his findings.

186. Revised Financial Regulations
