A test of the Localizable Sentences 972 font

The Localizable Sentences 972 font was produced by starting with a copy of the Localizable Sentences 971 font, and then altering the glyphs for the ten circled digit characters.

This is so as to produce a font where the glyphs for the circled digits do not relate to any particular script, though these glyphs are not intended to be used all of the time.

In addition four extra glyphs are added. These are not intended as alternative glyphs, they are intended as a record of alternative designs that were considered.

The design of the digit 9 was produced first. Eight designs were each produced from a copy of the digit 9 pales and deleting one or more of them, going down in numerical order.

The design for the digit 8 was decided after consideration of the two other designs. Neither of the two other designs seemed satisfactory and so two of the pales were moved horizontally.

The design for the digit 7 was decided before the production of the font was started, the two other designs are of what could have been used.

Here are the glyphs used in the Localizable Sentences 971 font.
