

A test of the Localizable Sentences 971 font

The Localizable Sentences 971 font was produced by starting with a copy of the Localizable Sentences 972 font, and then altering the glyph for the circled digit five character and altering the glyph for the circled digit six character.

This is so as to produce a font such that the glyphs for the circled digits from circled digit one through to circled digit nine differ each from the others by more than just the placing of one pale in a particular place.

The difference between the glyph for the circled digit zero and the glyph for the circled digit one is just by the placing of one pale in a particular place. Consideration was given to having a circle as the glyph for circled digit zero, but this has not been implemented at the present time, particularly as the glyph for circled digit zero is less likely to be displayed than other circled digit glyphs in a poster due to the encoding style used for the encoding of localizable sentences where the digit zero is avoided in many places so as to avoid possible confusion if code number digits are spoken over a telephone connection.
