



Originally designed for my friend Connie this little fish was intended as an earring but can be used as 'just a fish'!

**Skills required:** Knowledge of split rings and [down picot](#) with a bead – see abbreviations.

**Materials:** 3 shuttles – 2 with same colour 1 with contrast. 1 small bead for eye on Sh1. Earring findings.

Earring findings.

22 beads are needed to add to very long picots for each fish.

**Abbreviations**

R	ring	Ch	chain
– or p	picot	SR	split ring
/	after the / make 2nd half of SR	vsp	very small picot
Vlp	very long picot number of beads in ()	+	join
Lj	join made with shuttle thread	S	start
T & C	Tie and cut		
DPB	work 2 first half ds, bead then 2 second half ds and back to pattern – see below and <a href="#">this link</a> .		

Starting with 2 shuttles with same colour add 1 black bead to Sh1 before starting. Move bead to back of hand on Sh1 & make

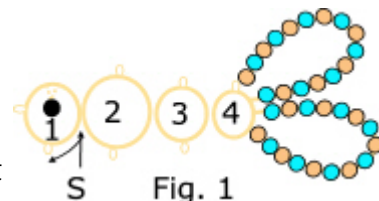
**Centre Body – see fig. 1**

R1: 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 DPB 2

SR2: 4 vsp 4 / 4 vsp 4

SR3: 3 vsp 3 / 3 vsp 3

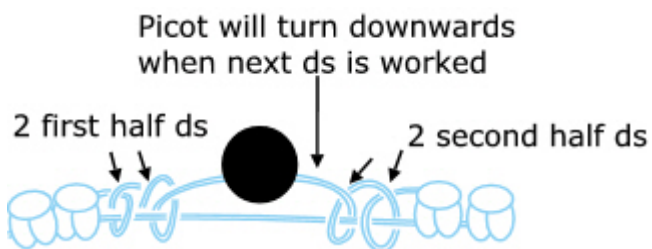
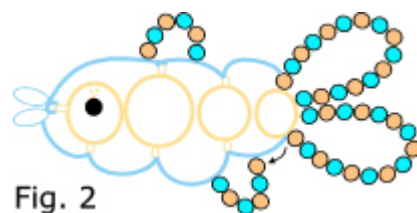
SR4: 3 Vlp (16 beads) 1 + B's (last Vlp) 1 Vlp (16 beads) 1 + B's (last Vlp) 1 / 2 CI SS Change thread colour on Sh1



**Outer Body**

Ch: 2 Vlp (6 beads) 1 Lj (SR3) 1 + (last Vlp) 5 Lj (SR2) 4 Lj (1<sup>st</sup> vsp R1) 4 Lj (next vsp R1) – 1 Lj (same vsp) – 10 Vlp (6 beads) 2 Lj (SR2) 1 + (last Vlp) 1 Lj (SR3) 4 Lj base of tail fin T & C

Hang each fish from the finding by one of the mouth picots
