VALENTINE



CHRISTMAS


As predicted in the last newsletter, the Christmas luncheon is on 15th December - don't forget to bring a draw prize.



CONTROL ADJUSTMENT.

To ensure correct adjustment, a slot is cut in the step through which can be observed the indicator rod A, which indicates whether the gear is correctly adjusted, and enables the rider to see from the outside if the hub is all correct.

The different positions which the indicator rod will take at the different gears is shown in sketch. No. r shows the step broken away to expose the position of indicating rod at the high gear. No. 3 shows the position of



the rod at the low gear and No. 2 the position

at the normal gear.

Make the adjustment with gear at normal, and get the indicator rod to show as in No. 2, by loosening the lock nut K and turning the knurled sleeve L, which tightens or loosens the screwed connection until correct adjustment is seen through the slot as above. Always tighten the lock nut after adjustment. Always keep the gear well lubricated.
